David Duhalde is a DC-based political and socialist activist. He holds a bachelor's degree in political science and East Asian studies from Bowdoin College and masters degrees in public policy and nonprofit business administration from The Heller School at Brandeis University. Duhalde is the current Political Director of Our Revolution – a progressive political action organization inspired by Senator Bernie Sanders' 2016 presidential campaign.

Currently, Our Revolution has over 200,000 members and 600 groups across the country (and a few in Europe). Under Duhalde's tenure, Our Revolution won over 70 races in the 2018 general election cycle, including electing Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, Rashida Tlaib, Ilhan Omar, and Deb Haaland to the U.S. House of Representatives.
